
Laminated Euro Bags





Offset printing is one of the most common printing techniques widely used for large-scale production. It ensures high-quality printing of designs and colors on paper bags.




Screen Printing

Screen printing transfers ink onto paper using a fine mesh screen, suitable for simple designs or printing on special materials. It can be applied to rough or irregular surfaces.




Hot Stamping
